2019 Ride For Doug

Last year, our Accessible Vehicle project raised \$10,000 towards an Accessible Vehicle that Doug would be able to drive. One month later, Doug broke his leg and was confined to a wheelchair full time. There was need for an immediate solution. **THANKS TO YOUR FUNDRAISING we were able to quickly purchase a used wheelchair van.** It's old, has a full time Check Engine light, and broken A/C, but it gets Doug's chair around. It lacks a power ramp, and access to the driver's seat—so our fundraising needs for a proper vehicle continue. For 2019 we once again have two different ways that your money can help. You can continue to support Muscular Dystrophy Canada, and all of the good work they do. Or you can directly support Doug through helping pay for an accessible vehicle that he can learn to drive in.

Option #1—Muscular Dystrophy Canada

MDC continues to play a major role in supporting all those with neuromuscular disorders. Funds raised by MDC go towards research, education, equipment, services, and other supports for people living with Muscular Dystrophy. Ride For Doug is proud to be in our 12th year of partnership with MDC.

Donations above \$20 made to MDC are eligible for a Revenue Canada Tax receipt. Please include your full mailing address for a receipt.

If donating by Cheque

- Make it payable to "Ride For Doug"
- Indicate in the memo line which Option you selected

If donating by Cash

Option #2 - Accessible Vehicle Project

This year (2019) we are continuing with our special project. We want to replace our temporary van with a vehicle that Doug will be able to drive in. Doug has already passed his "L" test, and we have started the assessment process. The next step is to provide a vehicle that Doug is able to drive in. Modifications for this purpose have been estimated at \$16,000 on top of the cost of a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

A van with a power ramp and driver's seat access starts at \$60,000. The \$16,000 of estimated modifications are on top of this.

Funds raised on this Accessible Vehicle Project will go towards bringing that dream closer.

Any funds raised above the cost of the Accessible Vehicle will be used for the next major equipment need that Doug has.

Please note: Donations to the Accessible Vehicle are NOT eligible for Revenue Canada Tax Receipts
